



In the first six months of 2023, we've seen a **27% increase** in the number of people accessing our food and crisis support service, a **19% increase** in the amount of food interventions (hot meals, family food parcels, takeout meals) we've delivered for individuals and families, and a **60% increase** in the number of casework sessions we've delivered compared to the same period in 2022.

At the same time, we've experienced an increase in costs related to running our services. Like most, our utility bills have increased since last year; and although we work closely with food partners and have good relationships with supporters in the community who continue to donate food and other items; the cost of purchasing food to deliver the food service has increased by **68%**.

We have a wide network of partners across the city and will refer into them for specialist support services. In the first six months of the year, we supported almost **1,000** unique individuals through our food and crisis support service, provided over **13,000** hot meals and food parcels, and delivered **1,160** casework sessions.

We continue to be overwhelmed by the fantastic amount of support we receive and our volunteers have clocked up **3,615** of volunteering hours over this same period, for which we couldn't operate without their support.
